ABOUT the Project

It is a ‘whole-person’ palliative care approach that improves the quality of life of terminally ill patients through relieving pain with medicines and by providing other psychosocial and spiritual support as well as helping families to cope with the situation.

WHY the Project

- Sixty lakh people in India are in need of palliative care in a year
- Only less than 2% of them are currently covered under any form of palliative care services.
- Many of the health care workers and families of patients are ill-equipped to handle their needs.

HOW we plan it

- Establish a model 25-bed Palliative-cum-Hospice Care Unit which can provide medical, psychosocial and spiritual care and support to over 300 marginalized and terminally ill patients and their family members annually.
- Organize a whole-person/interdisciplinary palliative care training programme for doctors, nurses, social workers and community volunteers involved in palliative care.
- Train and assist families in basic palliative care skills.
- Build a caring community of active volunteers to accompany the patients and their families.
